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Health & Permission Statement

Parent Permission: I hereby give permission for _____ to attend summer camp/workshop. I understand the event will be cancelled if registration minimums are not met.

4-H Assumption of Risk & Release of Liability:

I give permission for the child named above to participate in the Fayette County Summer Camp program. I understand that activities/events may involve certain risks of physical activity and possible injury and that Iowa State University and its 4-H program will provide each participant with reasonable care, but that ISU does not guarantee that my child will remain free of injury.
