

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-22

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TREES THAT MAY BE PLANTED IN THE CITY OF FAYETTE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

WHEREAS, the Fayette City Tree Board suggests that the city should diversify the current inventory of trees in the city to prevent the spread of diseases; and

WHEREAS, the Tree Board recommends that the "Official Street Trees Species List" be removed from Chapter 151 of the Fayette City Code and put in the form of a resolution so the list may be updated on a regular basis; and


WHEREAS, the following list of trees is being recommended by the Tree Board to be used for planting in the public right-of-way and when tree incentives are given through the tree program provided these trees can be obtained by a State of Iowa nursery:

- Red Maple
- White Ash
- Black Ash
- Ginkgo
- Thornless Common Honeylocust
- Kentucky Coffeetree
- American Hophornbeam
- Swamp White Oak
- Red Oak
- Regal Elm
- Eastern Redbud
- Corneliancherry Dogwood
- Common Witchhazel
- Merrill' Magnolia
- Star Magnolia
- Amur Maackia
- Pekin Lilac
- Japanese Tree Lilac
- Serviceberry or Juneberry
- Shantung Maple
- Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn
- Washington Hawthorn
